PARISH REGISTER: It is essential that the parish keeps up-to-date records of its parishioners. Please complete a Registration Form and let us know who you are and your contact details.

DO YOU KNOW ANYONE NEEDING A PASTORAL VISIT ?

There are **Orange** Forms available at the back of the church which you might like to take to bring back to us filled in after you have asked the person's permission.

ANOINTING OF THE SICK: This Sacrament is available to anyone in who is sick or old. It is not just for the dying. Please ask for it for yourself or for another.

GOING INTO HOSPITAL: In order to ensure that Roman Catholic patients are visited by a CATHOLIC chaplain when in hospital or a residential home, it is essential that the Catholic chaplain is informed of the name of the patient and of the patient's ward or residential address. This may be at the request of either the patient or a family member. You can also ask your own PP to inform the chaplaincy department in the hospital in order to have a visit from the Catholic chaplain. You can just drop a note into the Catholic chaplain's box usually situated in or outside the hospital chapel. Please note that, for reasons of patient confidentiality, the hospital requires that the patient or a family member makes known their need for a pastoral visit. The same applies when going into a residential home.

COELIAC: Hosts are available at each Mass from the PP – just ask him at the altar rail.

GIFT AID: The Church in this country receives NO financial support from the Government. So, we need to raise our own funding. If you pay tax, our Parish can claim back the tax you have paid on ANY donation you make. Please just complete a Gift Aid form and pass it to the parish office.
